1.0 Call to Order and Roll Call.

- **3.0** Discussion and possible action regarding California code adoption cycle changes as it amends the 2022 San Francisco Existing Building Code.

Discussion:

- DBI's Technical Services Division Manager Michelle Yu made a presentation regarding the San Francisco Existing Building Code (SFEBC) changes.
 - Michelle Yu explained the meaning of specific formats such as shading, underlined and strikethrough of the text.
 - There was a discussion regarding Section 314 Existing High-rise Building since there is a potential legislation will affect this section.
 - There was a discussion regarding Section 506 Change of Occupancy.
 - There was a proposed change to this section in 2020.
 - Both the Code Advisory Committee and the Building Inspection Commission approved the proposed code changes.
 - There are some new changes to this section in the State Code and the section number has been changed.
 - The San Francisco amendments can still apply to this section of the 2022 State Code.
 - Some sections will be renumbered in accordance with the 2022 Sate Code section number.
 - All no-change sections are identified in a code change form.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Action: There was a motion to approve the proposed 2022 SFEBC and move it forward to the CAC. Seconded and approved.
