Fee Waiver Program – Small Business Month May 2013

Honorable Members of the Commission:

At the regular meeting of April 10, 2013, the full Code Advisory Committee (CAC) deliberated on a proposed new ordinance (File #130284) recognizing Small Business Month in May 2013; amending the Planning Code, Sections 302, 355(a) and 355(e) and Building Code, Tables 1A-A and 1A-E to waive fees for the month of May for certain facade improvements; and making findings, including environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1.

The CAC forwards a unanimous recommendation of support to the Building Inspection Commission for their consideration as written with the following recommended changes:

- 1) Replace the words "façade improvements" in the ordinance description to "awning, signage and lighting improvements."
- 2) Clarify "Over the Counter" to exclude Historic Buildings.

3) Clarify that the waiver of Permit fees does not include any mandated state fees.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

- (a) May is Small Business Month and this Board desires to recognize the importance of small businesses in San Francisco. As part of this recognition, the Board elects to waive various permit fees for the month of May for awning replacement and installation of pedestrian level lighting as these fees have acted as a bar from many small businesses to improve their building facades and store fronts.
- (b) On ______, 2013, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. ______ recommending adoption of this Ordinance, and adopted findings that the legislation is consistent, on balance, with the City's General Plan and eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1(b). The Board adopts these findings as it own. A copy of this Commission Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. ______, and is incorporated by reference herein.

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BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Department of Building Inspection and the Planning Department the establishment of a process by which the respective departments will certify that an applicant is a small business enterprise.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the date of passage; provided, however, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be retroactive to May 1, 2013 should the effective date of the Ordinance occur after said date.

Small Business Month Fee Waivers for May 2013

Under legislation sponsored by Supervisor Katy Tang and in partnership with the Department of Building Inspection, Planning Department, Office of Economic & Workforce Development, and Office of Small Business, merchants would receive a fee waiver for permits issued in May for 1) awning replacements and 2) pedestrian level lighting.

Please note that the legislation is in the process of being reviewed by several commissions and committees before it reaches a vote by the Board of Supervisors.

The way permits are processed:

Awning Replacements

- Replacement of entire awning, including structure attached to building: Department of Building Inspection & Planning Department.
- Replacement of only awning cover: Planning Department.
- Any other type of storefront sign that touches the building: Department of Building Inspection & Planning Department.

Pedestrian Level Lighting

• Electrical permit through Department of Building Inspection.

<u>Fees</u>

Permit fees vary based on the type and amount of work being done.

Planning Department awning permit fees:

Section 355(a) applies to the replacement of the awning cover. The fee in Section 355(e) must be applied if you have wording on your awning cover.

Department of Building Inspection awning permit fees:

The DBI plan review and permit issuance fee applies if you are changing anything that touches the building.
