1.0 Call to Order and Roll Call.

Members: Stephen Harris, S.E.; Chair; Rene' Vignos, S.E.; Marc Cunningham; Tony Lau; Ned Fennie, A.I.A.

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. Quorum established with 3 members present.

2.0 Approval of the minutes of the Structural Subcommittee regular meeting of February 11, 2014.

A motion to approve the minutes. Seconded and approved.

3.0 Discussion and possible action regarding proposed AB-108 – Application of California Existing Building Code, Appendix Chapter A3

Standards for cripple walls beyond CBC, prescriptive and nonprescriptive designs are discussed.

Will continue to discuss in next meeting.

4.0 Discussion and possible action regarding proposed AB-109 –Seismic Evaluation of Private School Facilities : Application of Engineering Criteria in SFBC Section 3428

The proposed AB-109 was presented by ESIP. Minor editing, such as changing from 2013 California Building Code to 2013 San Francisco Building Code, were recommended. Voluntary criteria for retrofit is included though evaluation is mandatory. List of nonbuilding component/structures and possible exemption are discussed. SEAONC review not required because the AB is mostly administrative.

Will continue to discuss in next meeting.

5.0 Discussion and possible action on removal or replacement of brick foundation

No discussion.

6.0 Discussion and possible action on draft AB on Guidelines for the Structural Review of Special Moment Frame Beam Lateral Bracing used in Light Frame Wood Construction for Seismic Applications.

No discussion. This draft AB will be discussed in SEAONC.

7.0 Discussion and possible action on SFBC Section 3404.7.2.

No discussion.

8.0 Discussion and possible action on AB-102 Substantial Change expanding applicability to R2 occupancy.

This will be further researched by Pat Buscovich and discussed with possible input from SEAONC.

Scriteria for inspection requirements for façade+will be added to in future agenda.

Board of Examiners membership has 4 vacant positions for engineers to sign up.

10.0 Public Comment:

Feedback on Soft Story Program:

- (A). URM stem wall with wood framing above:
 - (i) If full story height, need to comply with UMB Ordinance (2013 SFBC Chapters 16B thru 16D).
 - (ii) If short stem wall (say 2g):

The foundation is not the same vulnerability as the soft story wood frame above. During earthquake, the foundation may crumble, but the soft story wood frame above may collapse.

- (B). Questions on retrofitting Pre-98 building per SFBC Chapter 34B should be directed to Robert Chun, Manager of Soft Story Program.
- (C). Fee for soil boring is high. Geotechnical report not required for this program unless required per SFBC.
- (D). Street use permit not required if no work on sidewalk or street (and no truck parking).
