As part of the Earthquake Safety Implementation Program, ordinance file no. 130119 was introduced to establish a mandatory seismic retrofit program for wood-frame buildings of three or more stories and containing five or more dwelling units. Screening process, benchmarking, allowing different alternatives in the engineering criteria are discussed. The 50% maximum probability of exceedance of Onset of Strength Loss drift limits in FEMA P-807 and other alternatives are deemed reasonable as discussed by SEAONC. If proved overly restrictive later, changes to ordinance can be proposed.

AB-106 on general procedures and AB-107 on technical aspects will be developed.
