

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE SAN FRANCISCO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO UPDATE STATUTORY SCHOOL FACILITY FEES IMPOSED ON NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Education ("Board") of the San Francisco Unified School District ("School District") will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting to be held on June 14, 2022, to allow for public comment prior to consideration of the report entitled "Residential and Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study for San Francisco Unified School District" ("Fee Study"), prepared by its consultants Cooperative Strategies. The Board will consider adopting a Resolution to approve the Residential and Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study, and a Resolution to approve an increase in Level One School Fees on Residential and Commercial/Industrial Development projects within the boundaries of the District for the purpose of funding construction or reconstruction of school facilities pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and Government Code Section 65995.

The Fee Study justifying such updates is on file at the School District's offices, located at 135 Van Ness Ave., Room 116, San Francisco, CA 94102, and is available for public review Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, from 6/3/2022 through 6/14/2022. The Public Hearing of the School District, to be held 6/14/2022 will begin at 5:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the Irving G. Breyer Board Meeting Room, at 555 Franklin Street, First Floor, San Francisco, CA 94102, and virtually (live streaming at https://sanfrancisco.granicus.com/ViewPublisher.php?view_id=47 and teleconference meeting which can be accessed at <https://www.sfusd.edu/about-sfusd/board-education/board-education-meetings>, a link to be posted 72 hours before the meeting). These matters will be considered at such time as this agenda item is considered by the Board of the School District.
