Government's duty is to serve the public, reaching its decisions in full view of the public. Commissions, boards, councils and other agencies of the City and County exist to conduct the people's business. This ordinance assures that deliberations are conducted before the people and that City operations are open to the people's review.

DISABILITY ACCESS

The Health Department is on Grove at the corner of Polk Streets and is wheelchair accessible. The closest BART and MUNI Metro Station is Civic Center, about two blocks away. Individuals and entities that influence or attempt to influence local legislative or administrative action may be required by the San Francisco Lobbyist Ordinance (Administrative Code Section 16.520-534) to register and report lobbying activity.
